Friends in Christ:

During the month of July, I will be on a "mini-sabbatical." I will be using this month to begin some writing about preaching that I have wanted to do for some time. This will most likely be followed up with further sabbatical time in 2025.

He has preached here often and his sermons and worship leadership are well known and appreciated. On Sunday, July 21 & 28, the Rev. Libby Conley will be preaching. Libby is a Mennonite minister. She has been worshipping with us and attending adult education sessions for over a year. We look forward to this new voice in the pulpit.

If emergencies arise, pastoral care will be provided by either the Rev. Bob Molsberry from July 1-19 or the Rev. Ryan Downing from July 10-31. Ryan is the pastor at Faith UCC in Iowa City and well known to many as a member here before his ordination.

The summer offers us a wonderful opportunity to slow down, to look around, and to see one another and encounter God once more. If we feel like we are missing something in our lives—missing deep relationships, missing ourselves, missing God, then we can use these days to start looking again, in a new way.

This summer, take the time that is given to enjoy this beautiful world in which we live. I'm not talking about anything hurried. Sit for a long time and look at what is planted in your yard. Take a slow walk into the deep woods. Float on cool waters. Become familiar again with your home, this earth. Let nature tell you about itself and about its Creator. Hear the message that there is a season for everything and a time for every purpose under heaven.
