**TODAY IS THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT.** We light the fourth Advent candle as we prepare for the celebration of Christmas. As part of our worship we are including last year's "Rhythm Christmas"—a delightful telling of the Christmas story filled with carols and lots of opportunities to make a joyful noise. You might want to gather any or all of the following for your use during the pageant: Wood blocks, sandpaper blocks, bean shakers, sand drums, rain sticks, small metal pots and wooden spoons, bigger metal pots and metal spoons, bells, tambourines, wooden blocks with knockers. And use your imagination to come up with other rhythm instruments!

**CHRISTMAS EVE WORSHIP AND GALA RECEPTION**: All of this will be online this year, but it will be wonderful if you join us. The worship service will begin at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, December 24. Our gala reception will follow on Zoom at 6:30 p.m. This year you'll have to provide your own cookies and hot cider. And we'll be able to see and talk with everyone who shows up! If it gets crowded, we'll set up some breakout rooms for small group conversations. The Zoom invitation will be sent out early in the coming week.
